## BOB BUMGARDNER

Bob was born 74 years ago at Blackwell, Oklahoma. He graduated from high school at Braman, Oklahoma in 1953 and has been married for 53 years. He and his wife, Ms. Joyce, have 21 children. They have lived in North Little Rock for the past 30 years and are very active in First Methodist Church.

His work career started at a zinc smelter in Blackwell, and after lasting only three days, decided to sell investments which lasted two months! He then went to work for Boeing Aircraft Co. in Wichita, Kansas and worked as a tool and die maker for the next 6 years.

In 1960, Bob went to work for a camera store and printing supply house in Wichita and became the manager in 1961. In February of 1966, Bob and the owner of the camera store had the opportunity to purchase a camera and art supply store in Little Rock by the name of Jungkind Photo.

From 1966 until they sold the operation in 1997, sales grew from \$250,000 in 1966 to a total of \$50,000,000 in 1997, with a total of 165 employees. The business grew from a single operation in Little Rock to include stores in Memphis, Tennessee; Jackson, Mississippi; Shreveport, Baton Rouge, and New Orleans, Louisiana; and Corpus Christi, San Antonio, and Houston, Texas. In 1990, Jungkind was honored by Arkansas Business magazine as Arkansas Business of the Year.

After Bob and his partner sold Jungkind in 1997, Bob retired to a life of leisure, or so one might think! Bob and Joyce have traveled to over 40 different islands and countries and have been in every state except North Dakota and Rhode Island. Bob plays golf three times a week, is an active master gardener and has collected over 850 antique Kodak cameras, is an extensive photographer and has learned the ins and out of computers. Bob first joined Kiwanis in 1966, but took a leave of absence for 3 or 4 years in the 1970's. He has been active since then and was Finance Chairman for two years and President of the Board of Directors for two years at Camp Aldersgate.
